INCIDENT SUMMARY: According to Sheriff Jeffrey J. Murphy, the Washington County Sheriff's Office was called by an owner of a building on Lick Springs Road in the Town of Greenwich for a report of a burglary.

On scene, deputies were advised that a male subject was observed exiting a building and then fleeing on foot after being confronted. Scott M. Bullard, 19, was identified as the suspect by a witness who saw him coming out of the building before fleeing on foot. The owner of the building reported that there were tools taken during the burglary. Bullard was later located and arrested at his residence. He was transported to the Law Enforcement Center in Fort Edward where he was processed. Bullard was ROR'd at arraignment and is due back in Greenwich Court on a later date.
