INCIDENT SUMMARY: According to Sheriff Jeffrey J. Murphy, on July 5, 2018 at about 6:30PM, the Washington County Sheriff's Office arrested a Hebron woman on several misdemeanor charges after deputies investigated a physical domestic that occurred on Big Burch Hill Road in the Town of Hebron.

Tammy A. Havens, 52, was charged with aggravated harassment in the 2nd degree and criminal mischief in the 4th degree after a 911 call was received accusing her of violently attacking a person she is familiar with during a domestic dispute. The victim suffered a small head laceration but did not require immediate medical treatment. Additional charges of criminal mischief in the 4th degree, obstructing governmental administration 2nd and resisting arrest were filed after Havens returned to the scene and struggled with officers during her arrest. While in custody and in the back of a Sheriff's patrol vehicle, Havens continued to be uncooperative and kicked the rear passenger window causing damage.

Havens was transported to the Law Enforcement Center in Fort Edward where she was processed and held for arraignment. She was released on her own recognizance at arraignment and is due back in Hebron Town Court on a later date.
