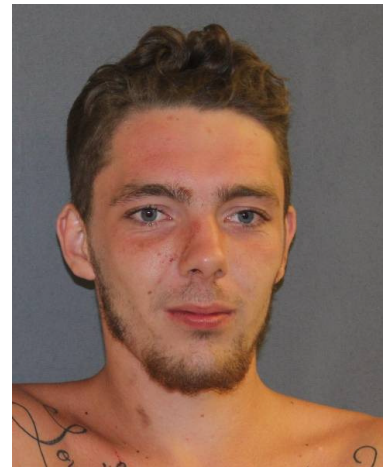

INCIDENT SUMMARY:

According to Sheriff Jeffrey J. Murphy, the Washington County Sheriff's Office arrested Kaleb S. Harrington, 19, of Salem New York. Deputies were called to a residence on Thomas Street in Salem for a report of a domestic dispute. After an investigation, it was determined that Harrington had entered the residence of a former acquaintance without permission while it was occupied. While inside, Harrington damaged a flat screen television by punching a hole into the screen and striking a female he was familiar with. Harrington then exited the residence and slashed two tires on the victim's car. Harrington had fled the scene prior to the arrival of deputies however was later located and arrested. He was then taken to the Salem substation and processed before being brought to Centralized arraignment at the Law Enforcement Center in Fort Edward. After arraignment, Harrington was sent to the Washington County Correctional Facility for lack of \$750 cash bail or \$1500 secure bond.
