## CONDENSED MINUTES MONTHLY BOARD MEETING MARCH 18, 2020

Fort Edward, New York, Wednesday, March 18, 2020.

The Board of Supervisors convened in regular session at 10:00 AM at the County Office Building, Fort Edward, New York pursuant to Rule 1 of Rules of said Board.

CHAIRMAN HALL called the meeting to order and presided.

Mrs. Clary offered the prayer.

Mr. O'Brien led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag and read the Fire Safety Notice.

Communications. The Chairman asked Tim Hardy to update the Board. Tim Hardy, Deputy Director of Public Safety stated that as of this morning, they are monitoring a total of 33 persons under investigation. Also confirmed the first positive case this morning.

CHAIRMAN HALL asked for Supervisors' comments. Chairman Hall explained that based on the guidance coming from the Governor's office and the emergency response team, he declared a state of emergency. Mr. Haff stated he is concerned about mass hysteria. He is also concerned about the right of the people to peaceably assemble. Mr. Campbell added that stopping mass gatherings stops mass graves. Mr. Shaw thanked Chairman Hall, the County Administrator and department heads. Mr. Ward praised and the dispatchers who are here 24 hours a day every day of the year and the Department of Public Safety adding that the preparation they have done has paid off. Mr. Wilson also thanked Tim Hardy and Glen Gosnell and the emergency response team for a job well done and for the informational phone calls updating the Supervisors. Mrs. Clary thanked Public Health for their work during this pandemic. She also announced that the memorial service planned for Jim Tomasi, who was the County

Attorney for many years, was cancelled. Mr. Henke also thanked Public Safety and Public Health. Chairman Hall also praised Patty Hunt, Kathy Jo McIntyre, Roger Wickes, Chris DeBolt, Glen Gosnell, Tim Hardy who have done an excellent job, adding that all decisions he makes are coordinated with them. He also announced that all committee meetings for the rest of this month are cancelled.

Mr. Shaw announced the adjournment of the meeting adjourned at 11:00 AM.
