Getting immunized is a lifelong, life-protecting job**



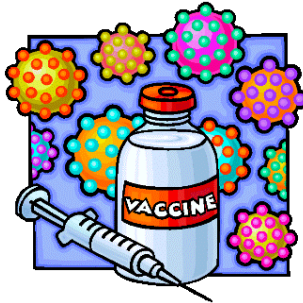
If you don't have insurance or your insurance does not cover immunizations(Shots), contact Public Health to see if you can use the Vaccine for Adults (VFA) program.

VFA gives free* vaccine to people who qualify.

If you are not sure what immunizations (Shots) you may need, talk with your doctor or contact Washington County Public Health.

Depending on your age, risk factors, and health status, you may need immunizations to provide protection from the following diseases:

- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Influenza (Flu)
- Measles
- Mumps
- Rubella
- Meningococcal
- Pneumococcal
- Tetanus
- Diphtheria
- Whooping Cough (Pertussis)



Most insurance plans cover immunizations(Shots) and you can get them done at your doctor's office.

If a Washington County Resident does not have a primary care Doctor, they can get immunizations(Shots) at Washington County Public Health by making an appointment.
