



**WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**  
**EXECUTIVE ORDER 2021.2**

**PURSUANT TO SECTION 24 OF THE EXECUTIVE LAW OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK**

**WHEREAS**, A national emergency has been declared by the United States as part of the response to COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, A state of emergency has also been declared by the State of New York and Washington County also in response to COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, We encourage all those in our communities to continue all efforts of 'social-distancing' and utilize face coverings as necessary as an effective public health measure to prevent and slow the transmission of COVID-19, rely upon facts and information provided by federal, state and local health and public safety officials; now

**IT IS HEREBY CONTINUED**, As part of the response to the COVID-19 outbreak and in an effort to continue reducing exposure and the spread of the virus to our essential employees and members of our community, Washington County Board of Supervisors Chairman Samuel J. Hall has ordered county facilities to continue to remain open to the public **by appointment only**; additionally:

- County departments will continue conducting business by appointment only, members of the public in need of county services should check the county's website for updated information and call ahead to make an appointment for services
- County employees and visitors to the facilities shall maintain social distancing and adhere to guidance from the CDC and New York State Department of Health

**NOW**, This Executive Order shall remain in effect for 30 days, or until rescinded at my direction.
